


Kate White ~ Have You Seen Me?


Started this book on 4/11/26 (Vacation book). Finished on 4/19/26.

Freida McFadden ~ The Devil Wears Scrubs




Started this book on 3/26/26 and finished on 4/1/26. Yes 6 days.

Groundhog day except you forget what happened the day, week, month before.


She started a small company that grew to a multi-million dollar corporation. Her husband wanted control and she thought she had a tumor in her brain.

Already read 1 Prey book this year. It was really good so I'm hoping this one is too.



Started on 2/22/26.


We know Freida. I'm expecting wicked twists and turns in this book!

Four chapters in already and it seems pretty interesting.


Finished on 2/21/26. 14Days!

Finished on 2/5/26. **9 Days!!!**


This one really kept my attention! The story was very well written. Characters were awesome!
