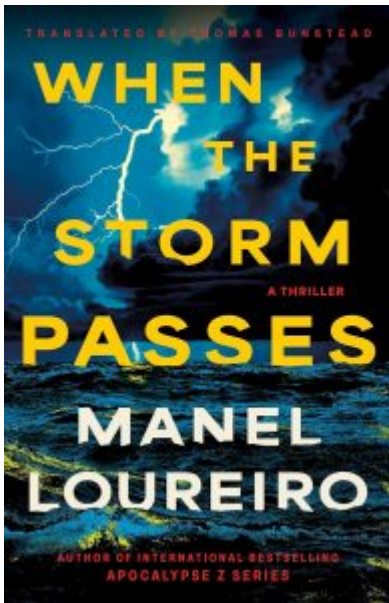


# Manel Loureiro ~ When the Storm Passes

Finished this book on 6/20/26. 10 days. Great book. Kept my interest the whole way. Characters are *very* well written and chapters were short.

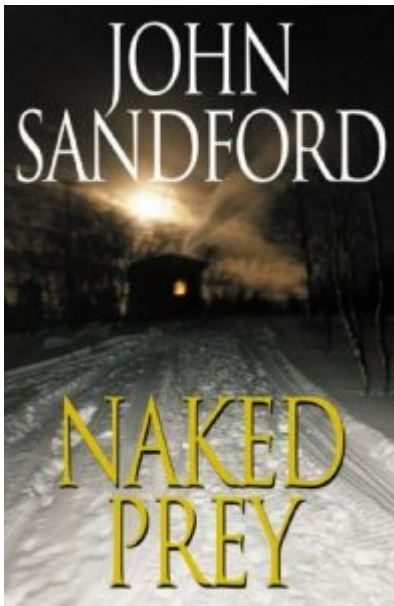

Finished on 6/10/26. 15 Days. Not to bad for a Davenport book.

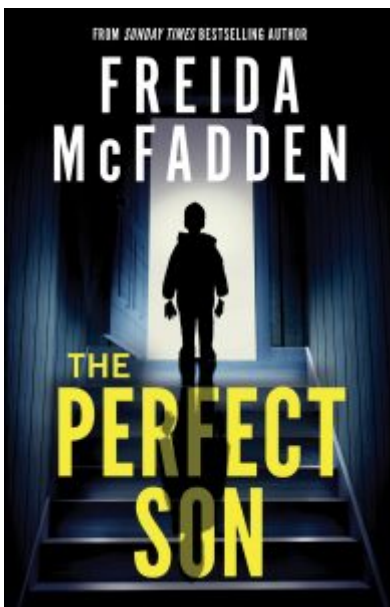

I couldn't put this book down. From the very first page & chapter it hooks you in.

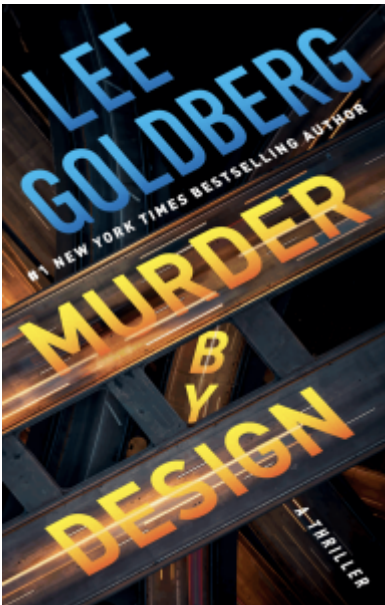

Bridget McGregor. Detective.

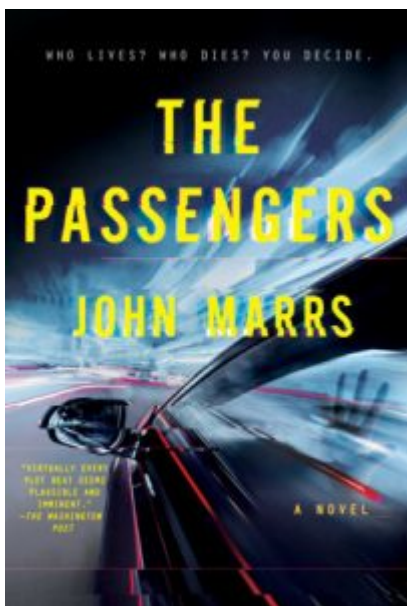
Finished 5/20/26. Really good book. Main characters well written. Names got confusing later in the book but mysteries were still solved.

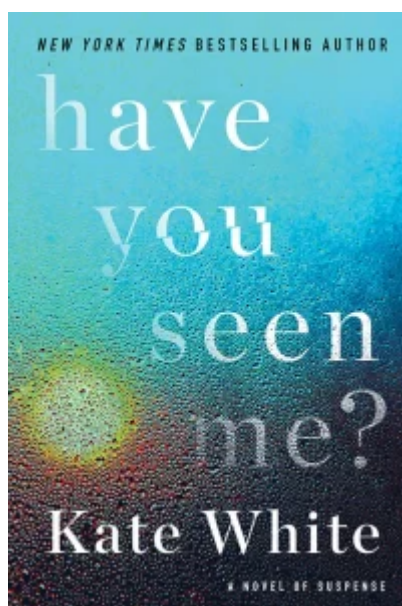
You'll have to read it to find out why.

If I wouldn't have been on vacation I could've finished this

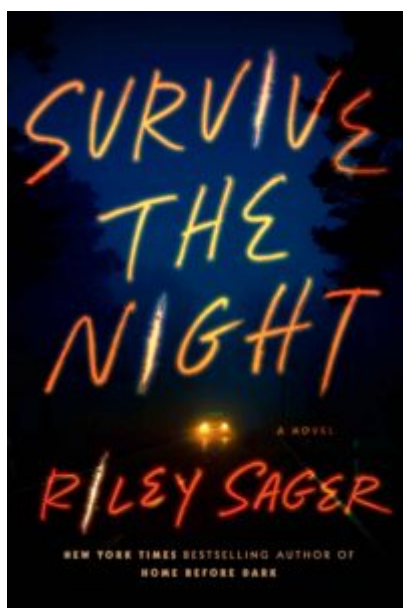
book in 3 days. It was really good.

It's Kendra's work life. Mean boss, always putting down.

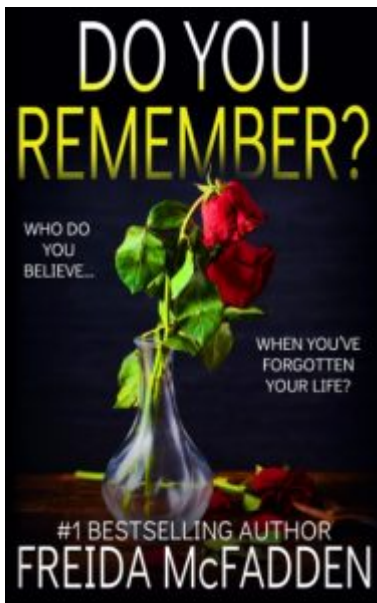
Others can do no wrong but she puts down this one intern down all the time.
