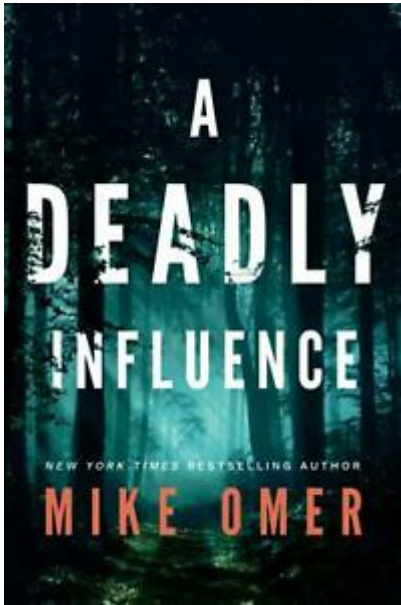


A Deadly Influence

This is book 4 of the Jane Hawk series.

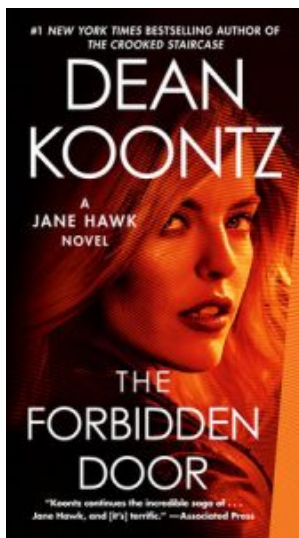
As with the previous two books, Dean repeats some of the key points in the series to make sure the reader knows what’s going on.
