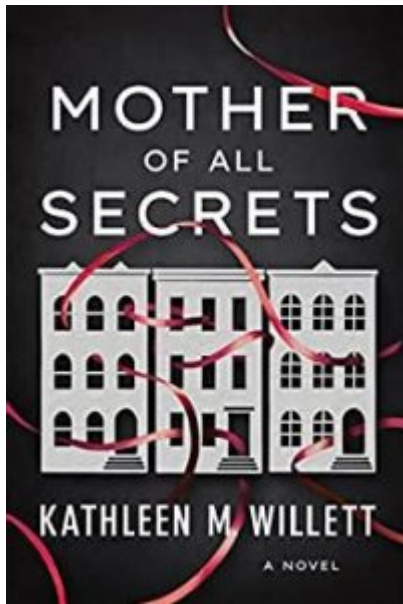


Kathleen Willett – Mother of all Secrets

I finished on 12/6/22. 10 days.

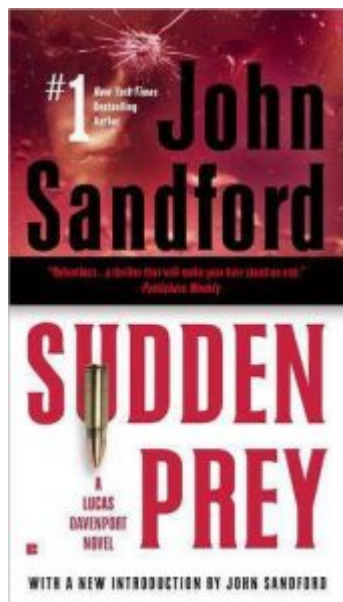
