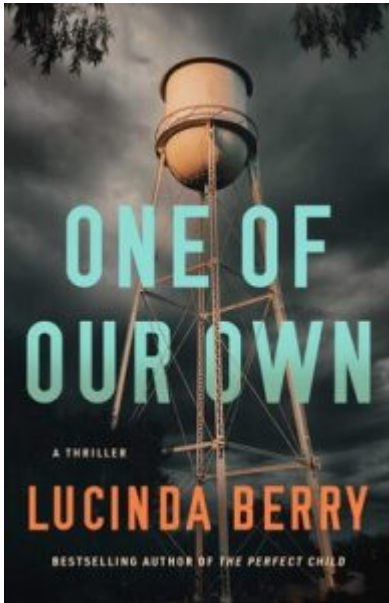


Lucinda Berry ~ One of Our Own



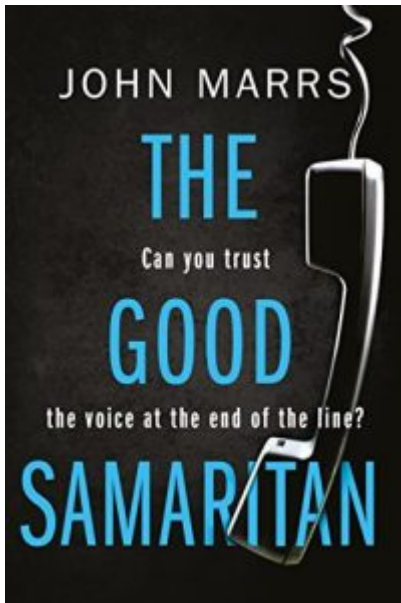
Started on 6/9/25. It's Lucinda so I have a feeling this one will go fast. I absolutely love her work and can't wait to start this one.

John Marrs ~ The Good Samaritan

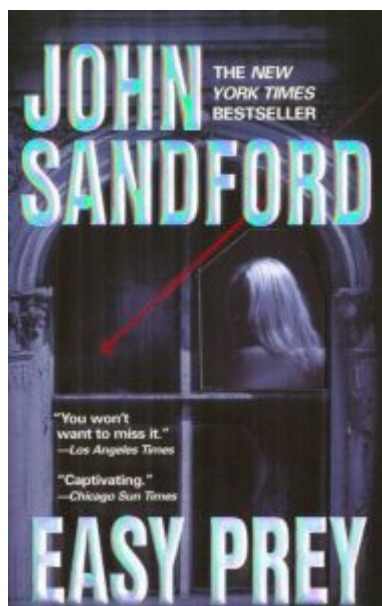


6/12/25. TikTok recommended this book. I've read John before. I just finished Lucinda's book last night. I think it's going to be along the same lines... haha get it?

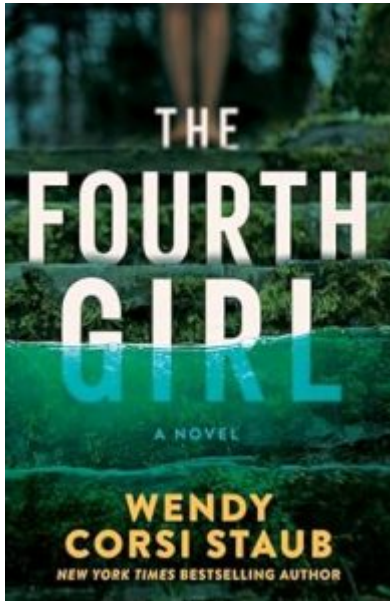

Amazon First Read: Started on 5/15/25. Finished on 6/9/25. **25 Days.**

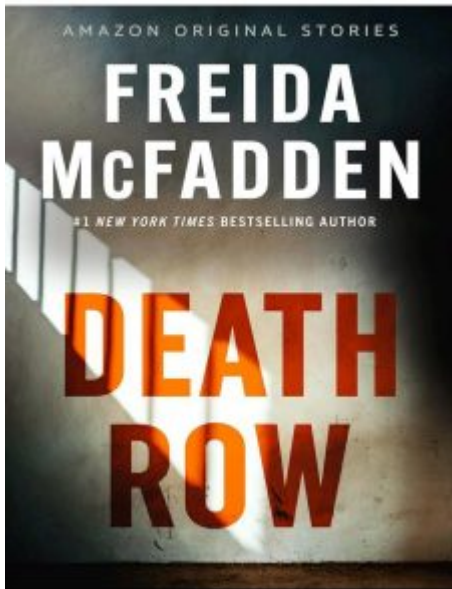
