


Todd Goldberg ~ Only Way Out




Started on 11/3/25 and finished on 12/2/25. 31 days.




Amazon First Read: Started on 8/12/25

Characters are easily recognizable.


Sadie, the mom sends her child to kindergarten reluctantly.
