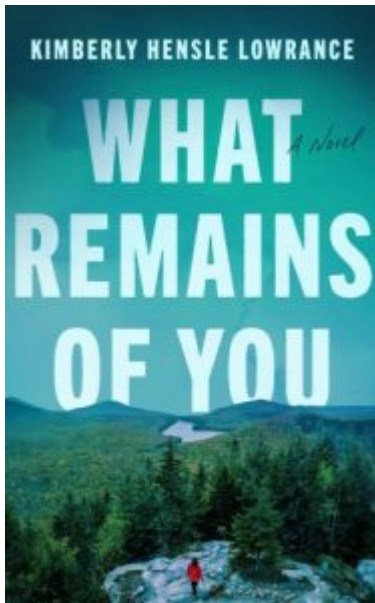


Kimberly Hensle Lawernce ~ What Remains of You
