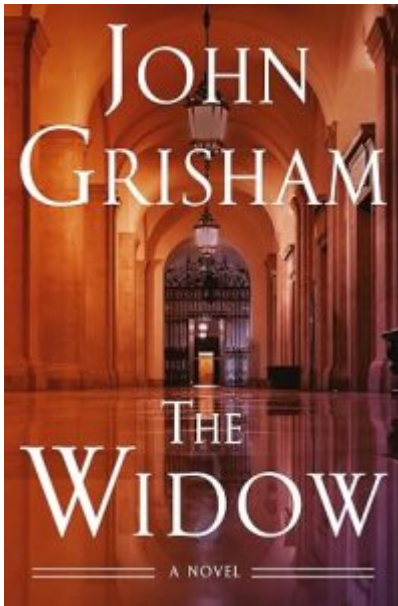


John Grisham ~ The Widow
