
# John Sandford - Night Prey (book 6)



I really enjoyed the book. Chapters were short. Story was good although a little predictable towards the end.



I broke off from reading my last book. It was not as interesting as I thought it would be. I started Rag and Bone on 5/17/22.



### Winter Prey - John Sandford






