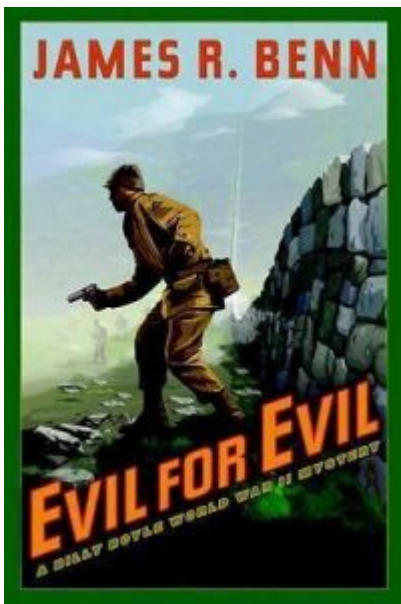


James Benn Billy Boyle Evil for Evil (book 4)

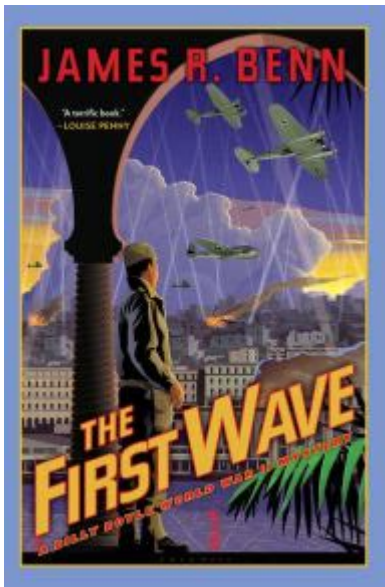
James Benn Blood Alone (Billy Boyle book 3)

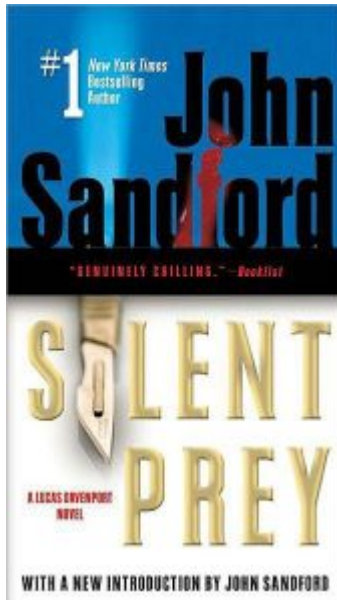


Giving this book a solid 9/10.

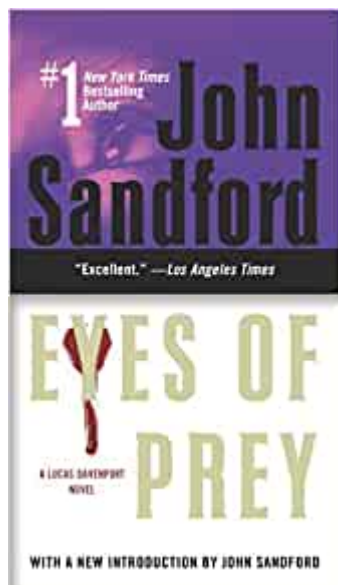

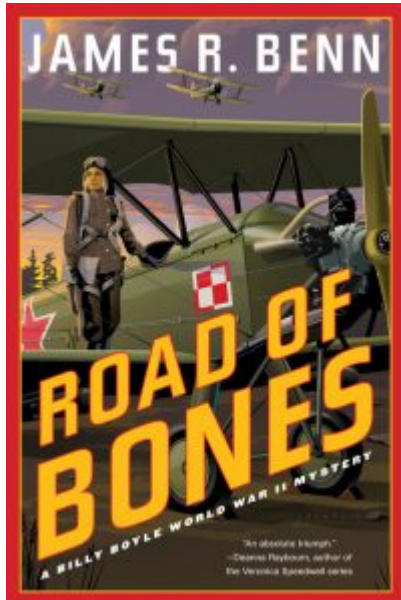

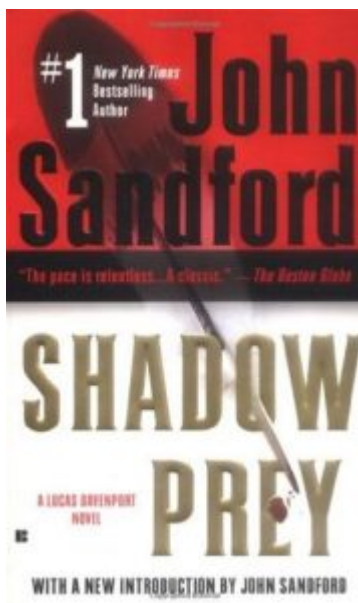
I give this book a solid 9/10. Would recommend

Lucas Davenport is a Detective in this book. The book finished

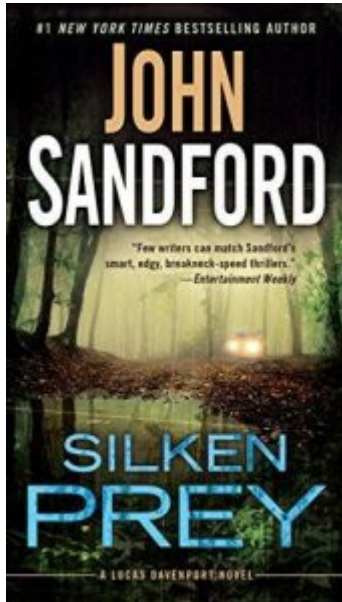
well. I'm writing this late so I don't remember much of how it ended. I just know I liked it. I finished the book on 12/17/21.

Silken Prey by John Sandford

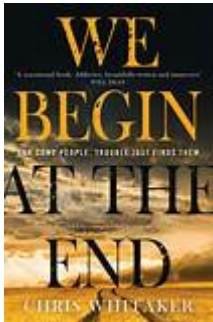
