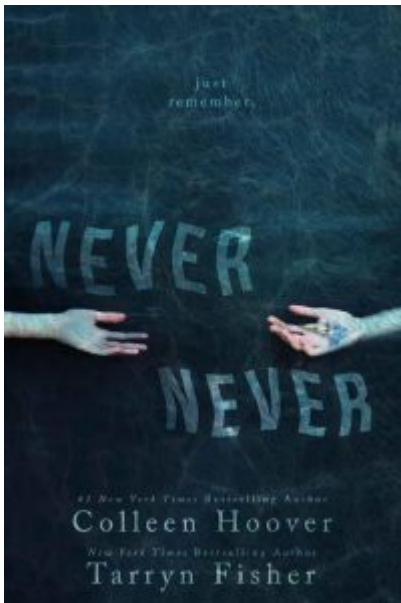


Colleen Hoover & Tarryn Fisher – Never Never pt. 1

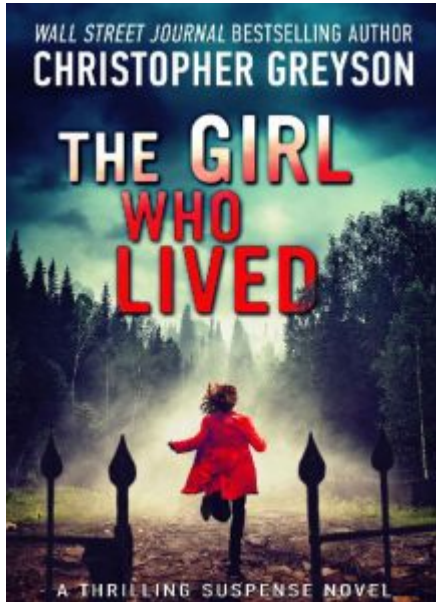
Kaira Rouda – The Favorite

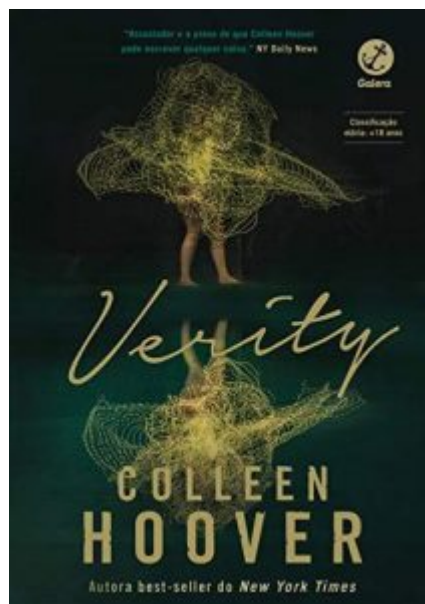

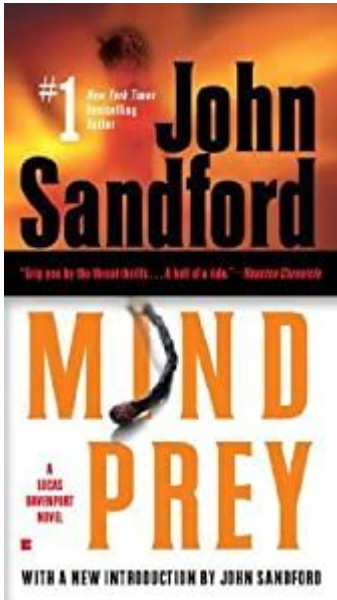

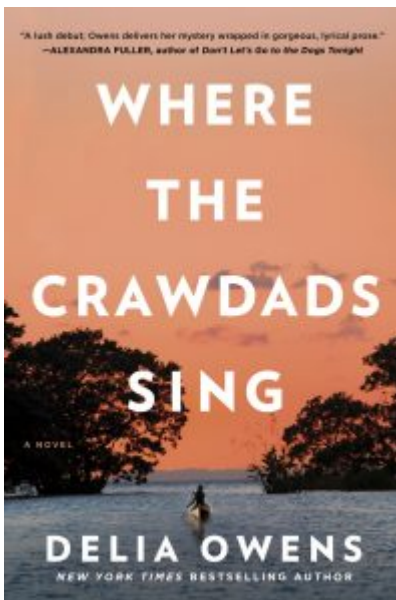
John Sandford – Mind Prey (book 7)

So who did it and why....

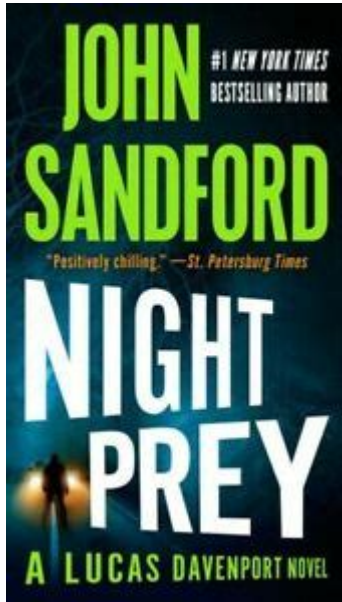

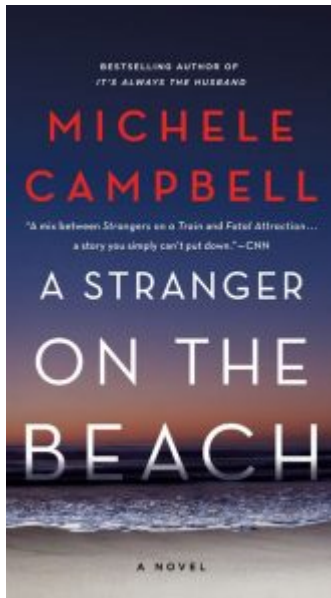

Aiden (the local bad boy) meets Caroline (the rich lady who

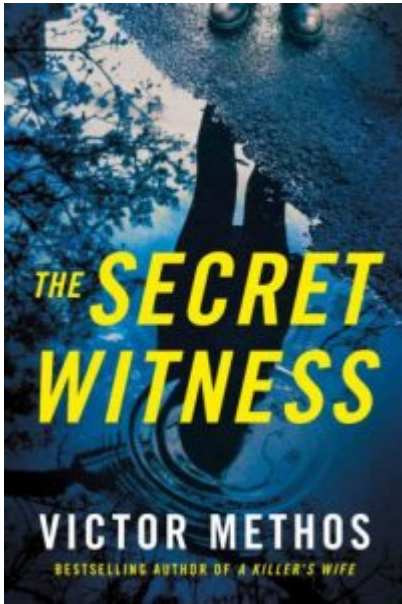
